This letter is an invitation to attend an outreach meeting for the MacArthur Maze 580 Connector Emergency Project. The outreach meeting will be held on Saturday, May 5, 2007, starting at 3:00 P.M. at the Hilton Garden Inn in Emeryville, located at 1800 Powell Street, Emeryville, CA 94608, (510) 658-9300. The outreach meeting is a networking opportunity for you to meet with potential prime contractors and to market your firm to them.

The Department's District 4 office has tentatively identified the following work items on this emergency project as representing possible subcontractor, supplier/vendor, and equipment rental opportunities:
